MilkWorks Coverage of Breast Pumps

Coverage of Breast Pumps under Nebraska Medicaid Heritage Health beginning January 1, 2017

Implementation of Nebraska Medicaid Heritage Health may have an impact on MilkWorks' ability to provide you a Personal Use Pump.



Personal Use Pumps

A Personal Use Pump (PUP) is designed for mothers who are breastfeeding well and require a pump for return to work or school, or for minor problem solving.

United Healthcare Community Plan (UHCCP)

Nebraska Medicaid clients enrolled in UHCCP may obtain a Personal Use Pump at MilkWorks (Lincoln or Omaha). UHCCP limits PUPs to one per pregnancy. The PUP may be obtained 30 days before the expected delivery date or after delivery.

WellCare of Nebraska

Nebraska Medicaid clients enrolled in WellCare of Nebraska may obtain a Personal Use Pump at MilkWorks (Lincoln or Omaha). WellCare of Nebraska limits PUPs to one per pregnancy. The PUP may be obtained 30 days before the expected delivery date or after delivery.

Nebraska Total Care

Currently, MilkWorks does not have a contract with Nebraska Total Care for Personal Use Pumps. We are not aware of any DME providers in Lincoln or Omaha who are providing a personal use pump for this plan. If you are enrolled in Nebraska Total Care, please contact them directly at 1-844-385-2192 and ask if you may obtain a Personal Use Pump from MilkWorks.

Medical Need (Hospital Grade) Rental Pumps

A Medical Need (Hospital Grade) Rental Pump is designed to initiate and maintain a milk supply when a baby is not feeding well. It is the pump of choice for a mother and infant who are having problems breastfeeding. MilkWorks is in network for Medical Need (Hospital Grade) Rental pumps with ALL THREE Heritage Health plans (UHCCP, Nebraska Total Care and WellCare of Nebraska). If determined medically necessary, your physician may write an order for a Medical Need (Hospital) Grade Pump, which will include diagnosis and rental length of time. Please bring your physician order and insurance information to either MilkWorks location (Lincoln or Omaha) and we will assist you with renting a hospital grade pump.
