While we are limiting in-person appointments to the mother and baby to reduce transmission risks and maintain as much distance as possible in our consult rooms, we are taking steps to ensure support persons can attend virtually through Facetime, Zoom, or other applications.

) You are welcome to continue to drop-in for a personal use breast pump, but you will need to call us from your car to request an iPad to fill out our forms in your car. Our iPads are sanitized between every use and has Wi-Fi connections from our parking lot.

) We are expanding our virtual shopping options. We are exploring opening an online store, but in the meantime, please feel free to call, message us, and/or shop through our Facebook Live sales. We are happy to be your personal shopper for your breastfeeding and baby needs while we limit in-person interactions to our consult clients only.
