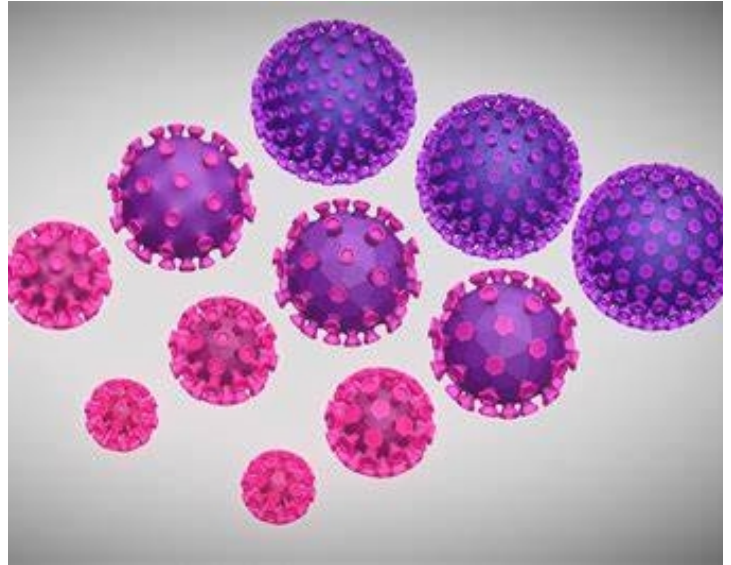


COVID-19 and Breastmilk Study

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What it is: We are studying if there is COVID-19 virus in breastmilk or on mother's areola/nipple. We will test lots of moms' milk to find out if the virus is present in none, some, or all. We suspect none. We are funded by the NIH. Based on what we find, better guidelines to breastfeeding families can be created.

Who are we looking for? Breastfeeding Moms diagnosed with COVID-19 in the previous 10 days.

What we are asking

- **e-consent** – we will explain this! (it means you don't have to see any researchers in person)
- **we will give you all supplies – including free manual pump**
- **Collect from you and your child.** These samples include mother's breastmilk, skin swab, saliva, and blood sample, as well as infant stool samples.
- **you store in your freezer – we will arrange for sample pick-up**
