

## Opportunity at MilkWorks

MilkWorks is launching a paid IBCLC Fellowship designed to expand access to clinical lactation experience for candidates who plan to become International Board Certified Lactation Consultants through Pathway 1. The fellow will work full time in our community breastfeeding clinic, earn the clinical hours required to sit for the IBCLC exam, and then transition into employment as a MilkWorks IBCLC for at least two years after certification.
